ROAD SURFACING

As part of the Streets Ahead works we are writing to let you know that we are due to resurface some of the local roads in your area. The roads that we are resurfacing have been chosen because they are in a reasonable condition but will benefit from the application of a new surface.

The resurfacing work will involve laying a new surface layer to the existing surface. The application of the material is carried out using specialist equipment with work typically carried out in a matter of hours before it can be reopened for access. Please see enclosed fact sheet for further information.

This work is due to start **mid-September** for approximately **2 weeks**. A list of the affected roads is included at the end of this letter together with details of our working hours. Works will take place mainly Monday to Friday, but there may be some weekend working.

As our work schedule is heavily dependent on the weather, we are unable to give you an exact start date for the work at this time. Please look out for the temporary road signs that will be displayed five days before work starts, confirming the dates of work and parking restrictions.

If you are away during the period in which the works are scheduled to take place please avoid parking your car on the road. We will tow cars that are delaying our works.

Our work schedule can be affected by unforeseen circumstances and so it may be necessary to change the start date at short notice.

Parking and access arrangements

There will be no on-street parking or vehicle access to properties on the roads we are working on during working hours. Most roads will be open and on-street parking will be as normal at other times. Please let our on-site supervisor know if you need vehicle access to your property for urgent reasons. Pedestrian access and access for emergency vehicles will be available at all times.

Bus service and bin collection changes

Changes to your regular bus service or diversion routes will be publicised by South Yorkshire Passenger Transport (SYPT). Please check your local bus stop or www.travelsouthyorkshire.com for any route changes. You can also call Traveline on 01709 515151 or follow @TravelSYorks on Twitter.

If there are any changes to your bin collection days these will be communicated by Veolia at www.veolia.co.uk/sheffield on Twitter @Recycle4Shef or by calling 0114 273 4567 between 8am and 6pm.

Road Safety

We are working with the Council's Road Safety Team to remind all road users to watch out for others on the road and think about their needs. Please be patient and take extra care during road works. Make sure to allow extra time for your journey. Stick to the designated diversion routes and always drive within the speed limit and to suit the conditions of the road. The difference of a few miles per hour can mean the difference between life and death. Think! Slow down.

Bogus Callers

If you are approached by someone claiming to be from Amey, the Council or connected to the Streets Ahead project offering to resurface your drive please do not handover any money. If possible take the callers details, including their vehicle registration number and we will inform the Police. All Streets Ahead and Amey employees carry identity cards. If you have any doubts about the identity of a person carrying an identity card please call customer services.

CAA5 - North – Road Surfacing

Please note this work will be completed under a road closure and there will be no on-street parking on the roads we are resurfacing. Vehicles left on-street may be towed away and you will need to pay a fee to have your vehicle released.

The specific dates of work for each street will be displayed on the on-street signs five days in advance of work starting. Please remember to look out for the signs.

Mowson Lane	Section of road, near Haggstones Road	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Morton Place	Cul-de-sac	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Elliott Lane	Sections of road (access to hotel will be maintained)	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Barnes Hall Road	Section of road near Raleigh Drive	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Agden Side Road	Section of rural road	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Windy Bank	Section of rural road	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Cockshot/Foldering Lane	Full length from Carr Rd into Bolsterstone village	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Springwood Lane	Full length from Greengate Lane to Hague Lane	If weekday 9.30am – 2.30pm as sch (if w/e Sat 7am -7pm, Sun 9am - 5pm)
Loicher Lane	From TPT (old railway bridge) to Jumble Lane	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)
Sunny Bank Road	Full length from Yewtrees Lane to Bank Lane	7am – 7pm (if Sun works 9am - 5pm)

Please note parking restrictions may also be in place on roads surrounding the ones we are working on. This is to ensure safe access for vehicles and machinery during our works.

It may be necessary to change the schedule at short notice. If this happens, the temporary signs displayed in the area will be updated.

We may also need to close the roads on additional days to adjust ironwork such as manhole covers and to replace road markings.
