## <u>08/05780 – Geo. Fisher Transport Depot, Green Lane, Ecclesfield, Sheffield S35 9WY</u>

There had been no objections received to the above planning application, however the Committee wished to draw attention to the problems experienced on Green Lane with congestion of traffic. The area in question is close to traffic lights and they felt that this could cause further problems with cars exiting the proposed site and also contractors' vehicles while the buildings are being constructed.

The Committee requested that the Clerk to the Council write to the Head of Planning to this effect and request that a site visit be made and that their comments be taken into account when making their decision.
