COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL

Finance & Premises Committee - Chair - Cllr Ms V M Bowden

The Finance & Premises Committee is responsible for monitoring the financial management of the Council and making prudent recommendations to the Council about financial matters. It is also responsible for recommending grants to local groups who are the very lifeblood of our community and who provide invaluable services to residents of the Parish. Most are run entirely by volunteers. They work with the very young through to the very old and represent the arts, sports, health and community cohesion. In the financial year 2011/2012 the grants budget is £60,000 which will deliver real benefits to our Parish.

Environmental Planning Committee - Chair - Cllr Dr J C Bowden

Meetings are held twice a month to examine the many planning applications received via the City Council for the Parish area and to consider their impact on the local environment. The Committee always pays attention to residents' concerns, and wherever possible supports objections to plans which adversely affect the area or threaten the Green Belt. Plans may be inspected at the Parish Council offices by appointment between 9 am—12 noon Monday—Friday. Plans can also be viewed on-line by going to www.sheffield.gov.uk and then following the link to Planning Applications on-line. In addition the Parish Council monitors all licensing applications in the Parish.
