

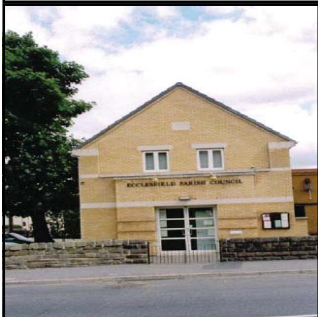

The room is available for the use of community groups and businesses at very competitive rates. Please contact the office for details of the charges. The Community Room is situated to the rear of the Council offices.



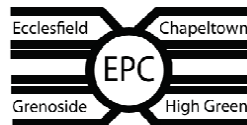

My year of office will finish shortly, so I would like to thank all my fellow Councillors who work on a voluntary, unpaid basis for the benefit of the Parish, and the staff for their unstinting work throughout the year, for without them we could not have achieved so much.

COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL

Finance & Premises Committee - Chair - Cllr Mr Graham Oxley

The past year has been challenging, but rewarding; challenging to meet the financial targets set in our last budget, rewarding to be able to achieve these targets while still being able to support Chapeltown Baths and the many various voluntary and charitable groups who contribute to the social or sporting fabric of our area.

After protracted negotiations we have sold the David Chadwick Centre. Money from the sale can only be used for capital expenditure. This will enable the Parish Council to pay off the loan taken out to build the Parish Council offices and undertake remedial work on the Parish Community Room.

The Parish Council is not immune to the effects of inflation and there will therefore be a small increase in the precept for the financial year ended 31 March 2014. This will equate to 25 pence per year for a Band A property and 37 pence per year for a Band D property.

Environmental Planning Committee - Chair - Cllr Mr Alan Hooper

Meetings, which are open to the public, are held twice a month to examine the many planning applications received via the City Council for the Parish area and to consider their impact on the local environment. Plans may be inspected at the Parish Council offices by appointment between 9 am and 12 noon Monday to Friday. Plans can also be viewed online at www.sheffield.gov.uk by following the links to Planning Applications on line. In addition, the committee monitors all licensing applications received in the Parish.
