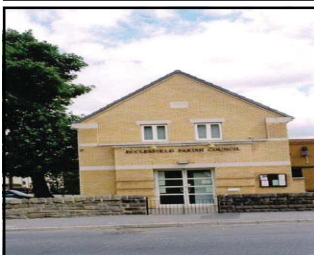

### PARISH WALKS LEAFLETS

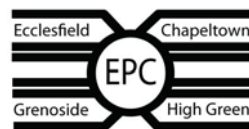

### A Message from the Chairman, Cllr Sheila Constance

I was delighted to be elected as Chairman of the Parish Council in May 2015. We are living in exciting times with many new developments in the area including the opening of the new leisure complex in Spring 2016. Memberships for the leisure complex are doing well and anyone wishing to sign up can call into the Parish Office where staff from the baths will process it. I should also like to pay tribute to the team of volunteers and dedicated staff who have kept the Chapeltown baths running for so many years.

This past year has been the busiest year I have known on the Parish Council and I have enjoyed visiting many schools and community group events. My chosen Chairman's Charity is the Bluebell Wood Children's Hospice and we have raised almost £600.00 for the Charity through various events held throughout the year. The Parish Council also held its annual coffee morning and raised over £1,000 for the Macmillan Palliative Care Unit at the Northern General Hospital.

The Ecclesfield Civil Archive Project is progressing well collecting local historical data from the groups within the Parish. The new archive website is available to view at [www.ecclesfield-district-archive.com](http://www.ecclesfield-district-archive.com) and this is an ongoing project.

Our Parish Councillors all work voluntarily to promote the best service and business opportunities for our residents. Finally thank you to our Parish Staff who keep the Parish business flowing and support the Councillors and residents alike.

### COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL

#### Finance & Premises Committee - Chair - Cllr Garry Weatherall

The Finance Committee will continue to oversee the Council's financial affairs in addition to the many grant applications and other requests for financial assistance which we receive each year. The Committee is excited by the development at North Active which will open during the financial year and this will be dove-tailed into the closure and eventual sale of the Chapeltown Baths site. The Committee will continue to monitor the expenditure on on-going projects in respect of creating a Parish Archive and public toilet provision in Chapeltown. The Committee has been realistic in preparing a budget for this financial year at a time of reducing national funding and felt it only prudent to increase the Precept for the financial year by 3% for a Band D property.

#### Environmental Planning Committee - Chair - Cllr Alec Henstock

Meetings of the Environmental Planning Committee have been held on a twice monthly basis throughout the year where planning applications submitted to Sheffield City Council have been examined with regard to their impact on the locality.

The Committee has also considered a number of licence applications and major planning applications in addition to commenting on the Sheffield Strategic Plan which is the blueprint for Sheffield going forward.
