### COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL

#### Finance & Premises Committee: Chair - Cllr Garry Weatherall

The Finance and Premises Committee has continued its work in processing grant applications to local organisations. Some examples of grants awarded this year are to 25th Sheffield (Ecclesfield) Scout Group, Friends of Chapeltown Park, High Green in Bloom, Chapeltown Advice Centre, Grenoside Community Association, Chapeltown Forum, High Green Primary School, Windmill Hill Primary School, Coit Primary School, Lound Junior School, Friends of Charlton Brook, Burncross Action Team, High Green in Bloom, Chapeltown in Bloom, Ecclesfield Conservation and Local History Group, Grenoside Community Association, Friends of Grenoside Green, Grenoside Scout and Guide Group and Ecclesfield Priory Players. The Committee has also continued its work in overseeing and monitoring the Council's finances to ensure that all income and expenditure is properly accounted for. The Committee recommended a modest increase of 2% for Band D properties which has now been agreed by Full Council.

#### Environmental Planning Committee: Chair - Cllr Alison Gethin

EPC Planning Committee meets to examine planning applications both commercial and domestic received via the City Council for the Parish area and to consider their impact on the local environment, meetings are open to the public and held twice a month. The committee also monitors licensing applications received in the Parish.
