#### A Message from the Chairman, Councillor Terence Bawden

In May 2019 I stood for the first time as Parish Councillor. If that wasn't enough I had the honour of being elected as Chairman of the Parish Council during its 125th Year. It has been a privilege to meet and support so many of the electorate at different events across the Parish and indeed the City. Not only have my fellow Councillors and I been working hard for our communities but we have also provided more funding to community groups and on local events, than was awarded in the previous 3 years. After years of neglect the Parish Council has agreed to refurbish and significantly improve the Alan Greaves Community Room, a public space available to rent at a minimal cost for social and/or community events. ## **COMMITTEES OF THE COUNCIL** Finance and Premises Committee

The Finance and Premises Committee has continued its work, processing grant applications to local organisations. The list of grants can be found on the Parish Councils website. It is always a pleasure to support the local community groups. In 2019 the Parish Council awarded grants to local primary schools for Christmas activities and Groups towards the provision of Christmas trees and lights across the Parish. The Committee has also continued its work in overseeing and monitoring the Council's finances and in 2019 purchased a bespoke Parish Council finance software package to ensure that all income and expenditure is properly accounted for. This year the Committee has recommended an increase of £11.72 per household per annum (for Band D equivalent properties) for their council tax and this has been approved by Full Council. This increase allows the Parish Council to put more money back into the local community.

#### **Environmental Planning Committee**

The Parish Council's Environmental Planning Committee meets to examine planning applications both commercial and domestic to consider their impact on the local environment and residents across the Parish area. Most are received via Sheffield City Council which is the planning authority for the Parish Council area. Meetings of the committee are held monthly. They are open to the public and members of the public can come to make comments about current applications and ask for the Parish Council to take these into consideration when making their comments to the Planning Authority. The committee also monitors licensing applications received in the Parish. Planning applications can be viewed online on our website at www.ecclesfield-pc.gov.uk and going to planning applications or at www.sheffield.gov.uk by following the links to Planning Applications online. Plans may also be inspected at the Parish Council offices by appointment between 9 am and 12 noon Monday to Friday.

#### **Staffing Committee**

The Staffing Committee was appointed to manage, recruit and retain staff, review and recommend policies that impact on staff and to ensure that each member of staff is dealt with fairly. I believe having this robust system of management in place helps staff to feel valued and listened to. This year a member of staff was promoted due to their hard work and endeavour. A new Admin Assistant has been appointed and whilst we have been without a Clerk since March 2019 we have had the support of an Advisor to Council throughout the year.
