Changes to First service 40 from 27 February 2017

Further to the e-mail below, I am writing to advise you of the upcoming changes to First bus service 40 (Sheffield – Catcliffe) from Monday 27 February 2017.

What is changing?

From Monday 27 February 2017, service 40 will be change route as follows:

The 0744 service 40 journey from Catcliffe will be amended to operate from Catcliffe, Morrisons via Highfield Spring Road, Highfield Lane, Orgreave Lane, Handsworth Road, Richmond Road then 40 route to Manor Top then City Road Granville Road (All Saints School) before continuing onto Sheffield City Centre as now.

Why are the changes being made?

These changes are being following ongoing discussions with All Saints School and First. The above route change is being made to better serve All Saints School following the cancellation of the 787 school bus by MASS Brightbus. February.

How is this being communicated to customers?

The school have been informed of the above and details will be available for passengers shortly at travelsouthyorkshire.com and timetable information will be displayed at all affected bus stops.

I am writing to advise you that South Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive (SYPTE) have recently been informed that MASS Brightbus will be cancelling or amending some of their commercially operated school services from **3 January 2017**.

What is the impact on schools in Sheffield?

These changes affect 8 school services in Sheffield as follows:

641 - Brinsworth School - Tinsley

670 - Aston Academy - Treeton

728 - Ecclesfield School - Chapeltown - Burncross - High Green
