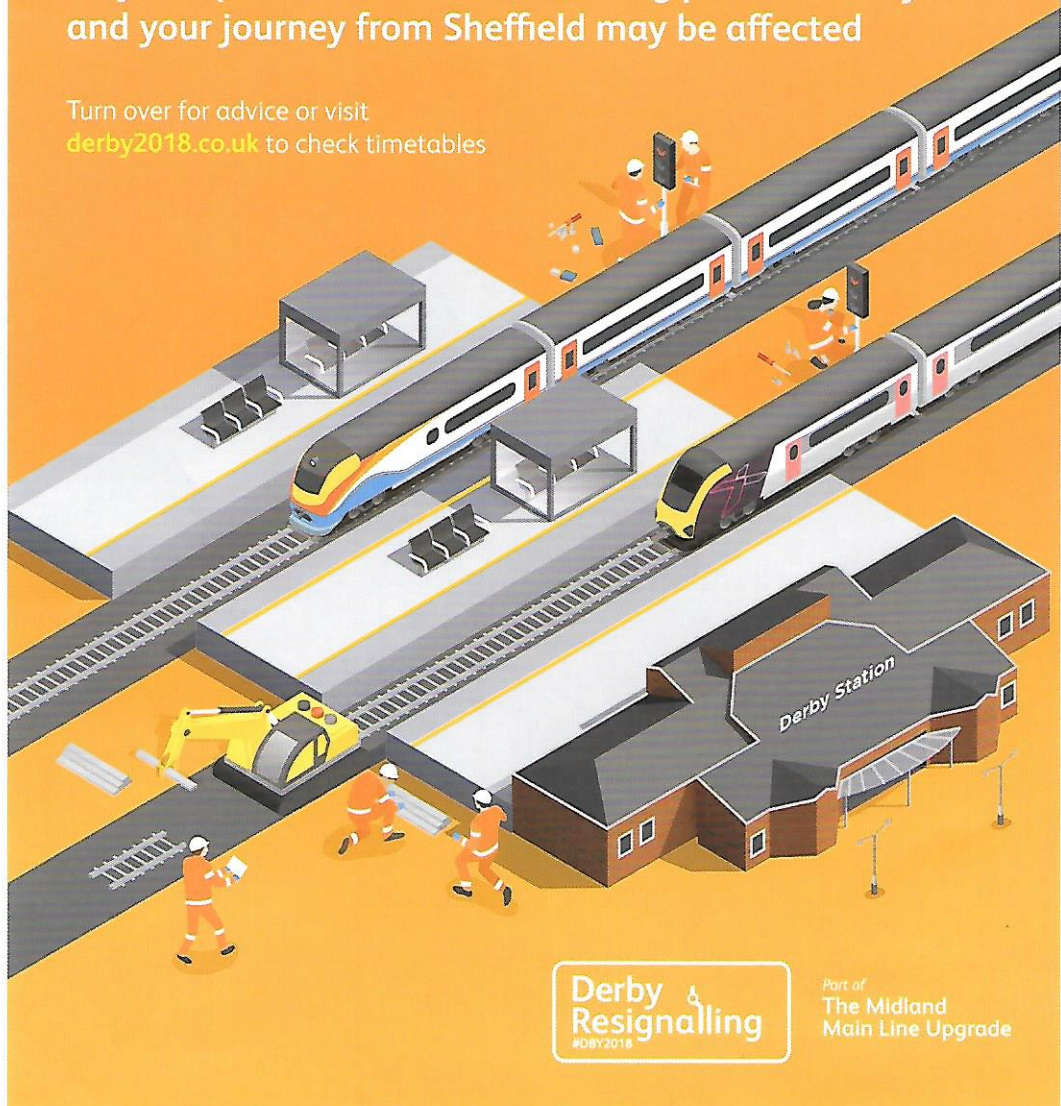


# Travelling by train between 22<sup>nd</sup> July and 7<sup>th</sup> October?

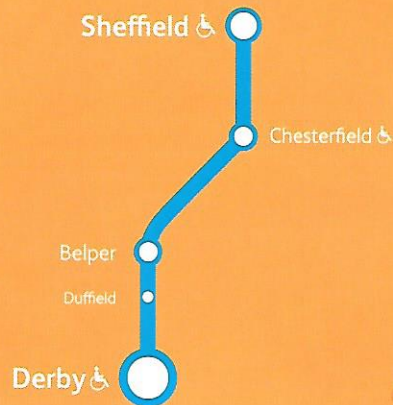

Between 22<sup>nd</sup> July and 7<sup>th</sup> October, major improvement works are taking place in and around Derby station. If you are travelling to or from Derby during this time, your journey will be disrupted.



### 30<sup>th</sup> July to 3<sup>rd</sup> September

No direct services between Sheffield and Derby. A rail replacement bus service will run between Chesterfield and Derby, with up to four services per hour.

There are various rail services between Chesterfield and Sheffield, with up to five services per hour.

### London services:

#### 30<sup>th</sup> July to 7<sup>th</sup> October

One train per hour to and from London, calling at Chesterfield and Leicester only. It will not call at Derby.

### What is Derby Resignalling?

The biggest investment to the railway in Derby for decades. It will provide better journeys for the millions of passengers who travel to, through and from the station every year.

During 79 days of carefully planned work, 17 kilometres of track, 79 sets of points and 55 signals will be installed and parts of the platforms will be rebuilt.
