Dear Enforcement Officer,

Re: Application Number: 20/02057/FUL: Erection of 2 no. dwellings with associated parking - Land Between 94 And 98 Wheel Lane Grenoside (Amended plans 03/12/20)

We feel it is imperative that enforcement action is taken to remove building work that took place in 2018 on this site without planning permission. We are now into the third year of ongoing similar planning applications being refused and these works have still not been removed. The reason given by planning officers for not taking enforcement action being that there was a new application in the pipeline. Action must now be taken to enforce the removal of these unsightly and illegally built footings.

There are also 2 shipping containers on site stacked (in my opinion) provocatively one on top of the other in order to make them even more visible to the neighbourhood. I cannot imagine what can be inside these containers as there should be no activity on this site as it has no planning permission. This seems to me to be a defiant act to cause maximum distress to local residents.

I am copying this to my local City Councillors and Ecclesfield Parish Councillors who I have previously spoken to about issues on this site.
