

# Pandemic Monument—Sculpture Competition and Monument Rocks

**Overview:** To mark the Pandemic and we are hoping to place a memorial sculpture and seating area in Chapeltown Park where members of the Parish can remember how life was during lockdown and those loved ones who were lost. It will be positioned on the corner just above the outdoor gym and overlook Chapeltown.



The red dot is where the monument will be a the line is the line of sight over Chapeltown

There will also be a seating area, within which, we will be using painted rocks decorated by Children and adults from the Parish, showing what the Pandemic meant to them, whether that be how they felt, what they did, words, rainbows—anything goes really.

There will be smaller monument areas in each of the ward's parks in the Parish as well, which we will be marked with painted rocks and plaques.

## Get Involved...

**1. Painted Rocks**— Paint some rocks showing your feelings and experiences during lockdown and the pandemic and hand them into school with your name, age and school written on the back. We will then collect these ready to use within the monuments. You can do as many as you like. Please make sure these are handed into school on or before **Wednesday 21st April**.



## 2. Monument Design Competition

Objective: To design the monument which will be around for years to come. The winning entry will be used by the sculptors to influence the final design, and the winner will be presented with an art set.

Your design must include the following design points:

- The sculpture will be made of stone
- There will be a seating area around it
- There will be a small wall which will hold painted rocks from the children of the Parish
- The monument design must fit within a rectangular dimensions and may be up to 1.5m tall once built
- Entries can be created by an individual or a group of children, or even a whole class from any of the schools inside the Parish
- To enter simply fill in your entry form attached and hand into school before **Monday 29th March**.
