

Introduction from Sergeant Cook

The new team covering Ecclesfield, Chapeltown, High Green and Grenoside was introduced in December 2020 so have now been operational for just over 2 months. The team is made up of both Police Constables and Police Community Support Officers. Since the formation of the team I have been working to identify what the main issues are in the area and what matters most to the community. I have attended many virtual meetings with community groups and council departments and we recently completed a community survey. Thank you to everybody who completed the survey and those who have invited us into your groups.

What have told us matters most from your survey.

- 1) Off Road Bikes We work alongside the dedicate SYP Off Road Team to tackle this. Information from the community is key so if you have information to assist please contact us.
- 2) Fly Tipping Please report this to Sheffield City Council
- 3) Drug Dealing Personal possession of illegal drugs funds this activity so we will tackle both dealers and users in the community, if you have any information please contact us or report anonymously via Crimestoppers
- 4) Speeding We will be out in the community enforcing speed limits in addition to those routes enforced by South Yorkshire Safer Roads Partnership

We are pleased to hear the community have seen an increased policing presence since the introduction of a dedicated team and this will continue to increase. We patrol on foot, in cars and on bikes.

Crime and Antisocial Behaviour Update

Crime and Antisocial behaviour remain relatively low within the area with the main complaint being around nuisance use of vehicles both on and off road. We will be working with our Response and CID colleagues to tackle acquisitive crimes
