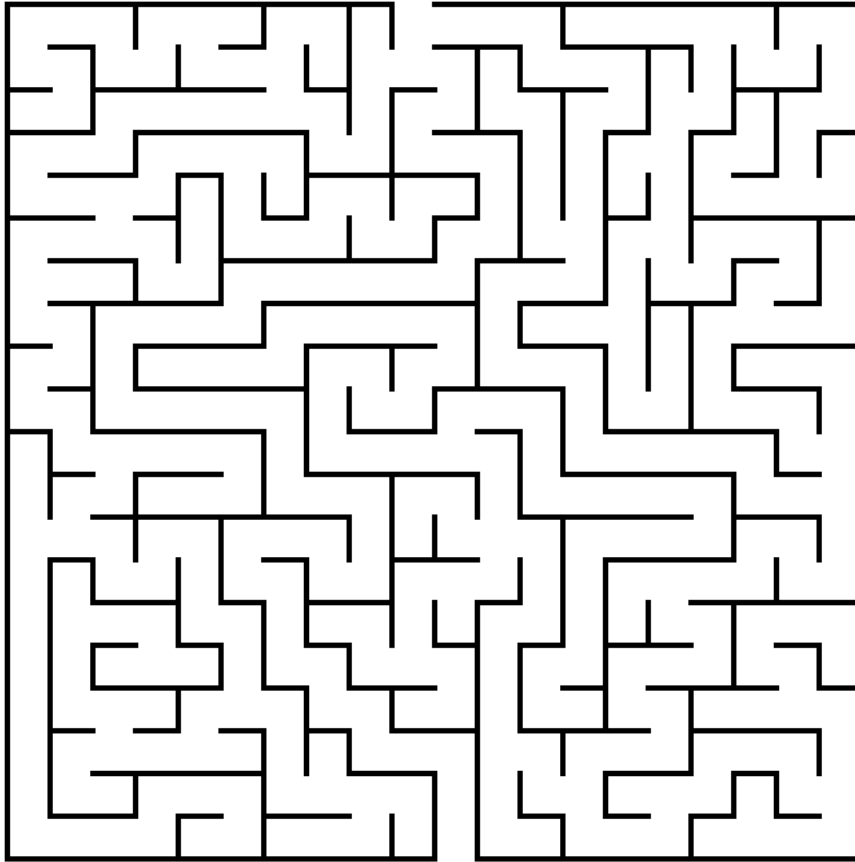

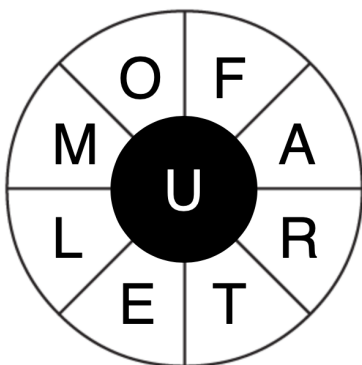

When I am gone.

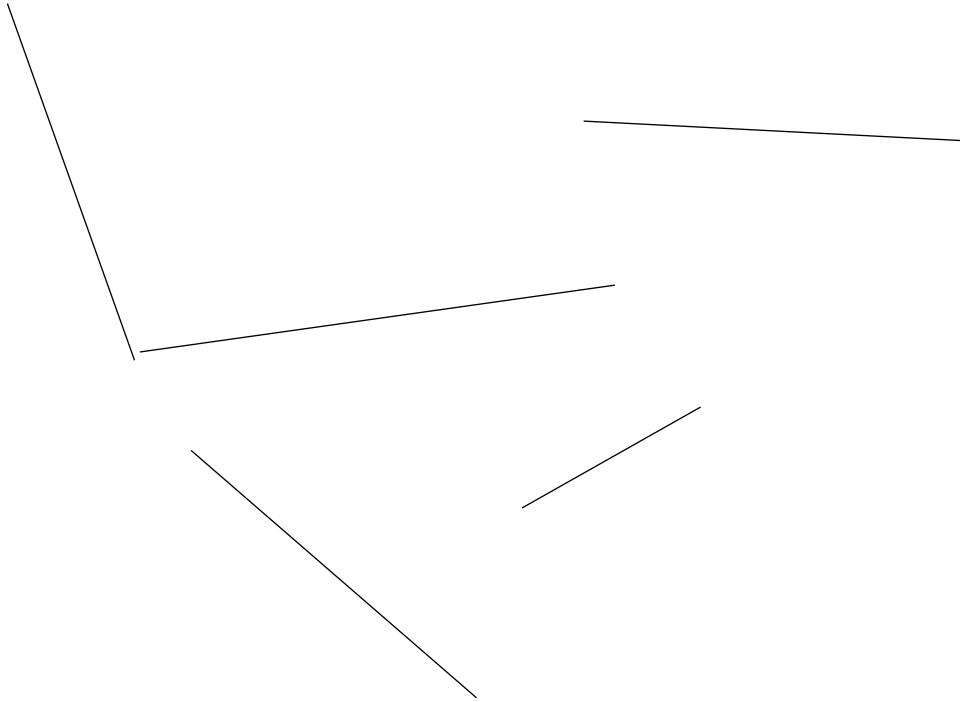

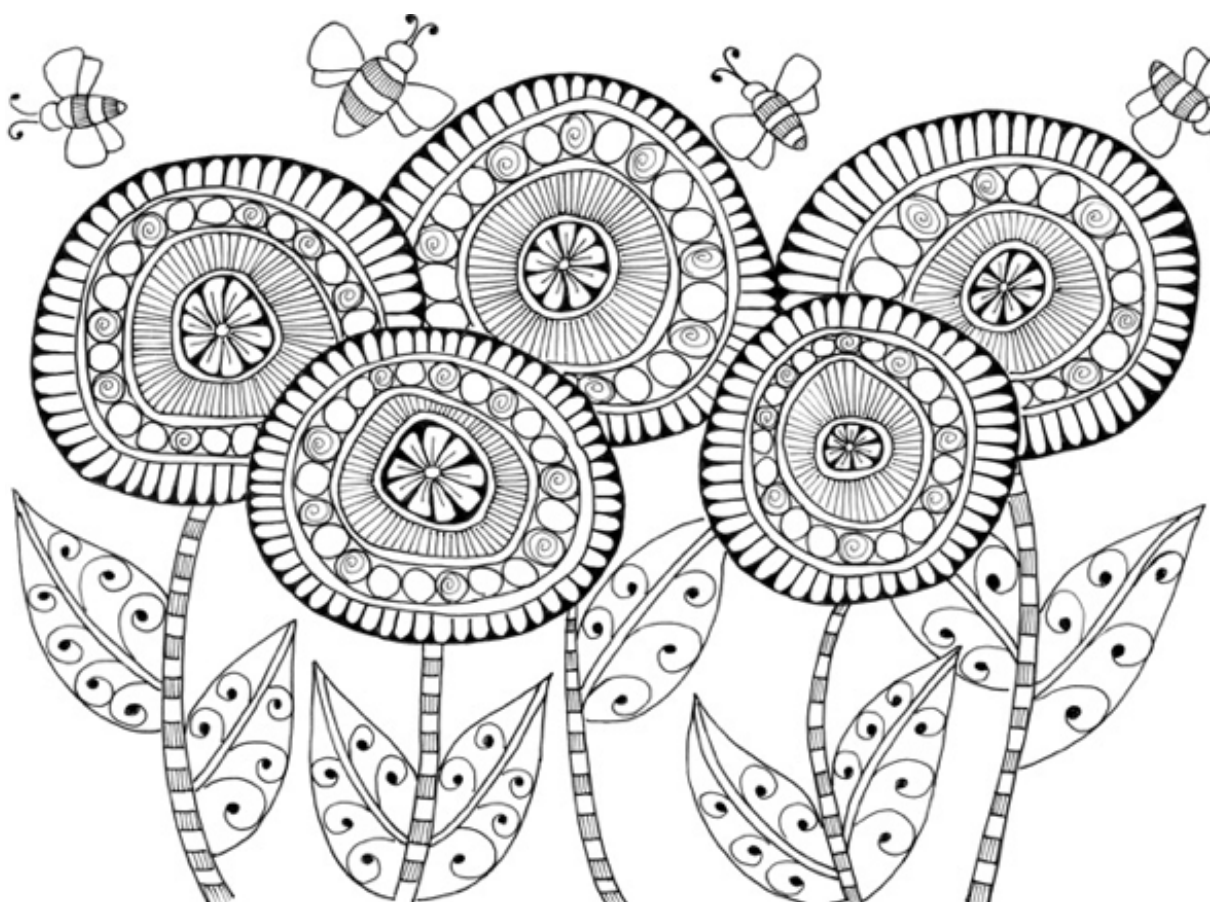

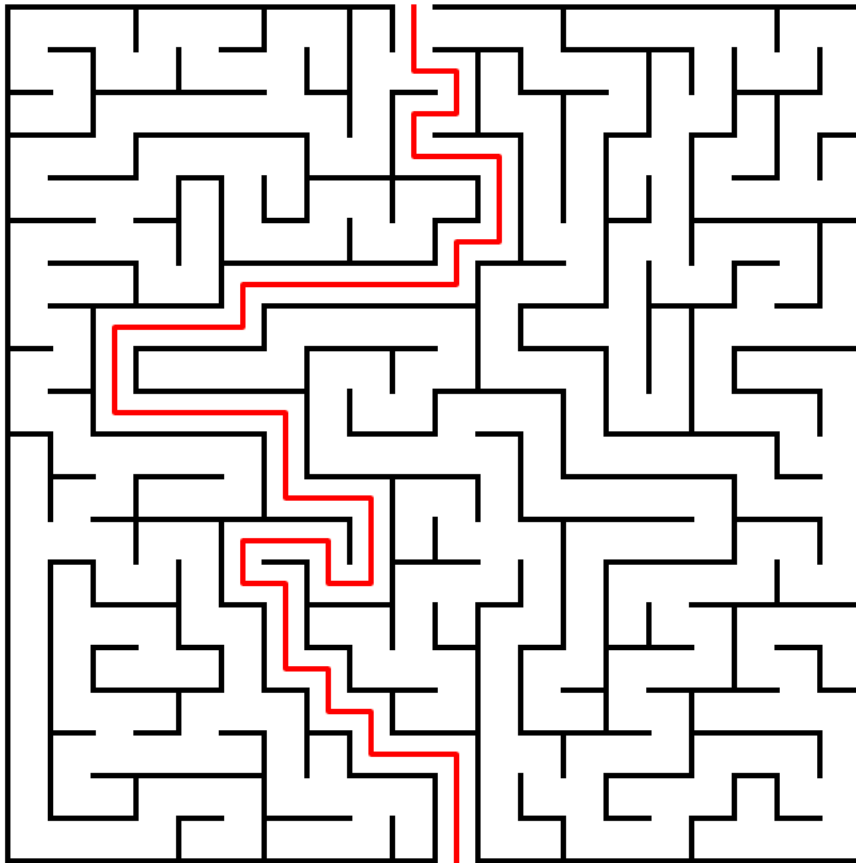
