Hi Andrew,

Thanks for your email about the above and please accept my apologies about the late reply.

A request about this issue was received in 2014 and the investigation concluded that it was inappropriate to introduce double yellow lines whilst the solid double white line system is present in the centre of the road.

I am not aware of who advised Cllr Scott that the double yellow lines could be introduced as the above mentioned Council position contradicts this. Similarly, the speed indication devices (SIDs) were supported and introduced by the Community Assemblies some years ago and we have not had any funding for new ones since then. The responsibility of the SIDs devolved to the Wards when the Community Assemblies were disbanded, unfortunately many SIDs were not maintained and have since stopped working.

However, I have discussed the issues with our design team and there is a potential solution whereby the solid double white line system could be replaced with standard centre line markings and lengths of double yellow lines introduced. This would cost in the order of £15,000.

There is no provision in any of our allocations this year for a project outside the school, therefore would the Parish Council be interested in promoting a scheme here from their own resources? We would need the approval of the Police to remove the solid white lines and this would be requested if the Parish Council indicated that they want to proceed.

With respect to the provision of a SID, this could be something that the LACs may be interested in as the reintroduction of a coherent City-wide network would have a positive impact on driver speeds. If there is a desire to reintroduce SIDs, the site would need to be assessed because the limited footway widths and existing underground utilities may prevent the deployment of one.

Thank you for your enquiry and I look forward to your response regarding funding.
