Item 109: Environmental Project Updates

- 1) Chapeltown Library – The Clerk gave an update to the Committee on the wilding of areas within the Parish for bugs and the installation of bug hotels. This will be ongoing within the Parish in different areas at local businesses and schools.
- 2) Environmental Clean-up date – Cllr Whitaker informed the Committee that a clean-up day at Angram Bank Park had been arranged for 9 April, but as this would be during Purdah, the date has now been changed to 7 May. A skip will be hired, and the event will be advertised for any parishioners wishing to attend and join in. Cllr Whitaker also informed the Committee that the day will be manned by Councillors and staff.
- 3) School Uniform Swap Shop – The Clerk updated the Committee that a uniform swap shop has been arranged for the 26 March at the Council office. The day will be manned by 2 members of Staff. This was noted by the Committee.

Item 110: To consider the purchase of 6 waste bins

The Clerk asked the Committee to consider the purchase of 6 more dog waste bins around the Parish. Cllr Hooper updated the Committee on the issues with the provision of dog waste bins around the Parish. He explained that they were no longer dog bins, they are multi waste bins. It was explained that it was easier to place them in Parks, as there can be complications in placing them on streets, and extra costs will be involved. It

As Cllr Victoria Bowden was at the Environmental Planning meeting the Clerk invited her to give the Committee some more information on this enquiry, as she has been involved with it as a Sheffield City Councillor. Decisions are still being considered at Sheffield City Council as to what to do with the property. It was suggested that the Parish Council write to Sheffield City Council's Planning Department and Conservation Team in support of the resident's request and that an update be provided to the resident who made the enquiry.</p>
