**Subject:** Litter on Greengate Lane and in Angram Bank Park (Foster Way)

There is a large amount of litter outside the shops on Greengate Lane and outside the maisonettes adjacent to the shops. There is also a lot of litter in the far corner of Angram Bank Park on Foster Way, particularly in the grass area behind the skate park.

I have tried to use the Sheffield Council website to report these matters but it doesn't seem to be working properly (again) and as it is an ongoing issue that the Council isn't getting on top of I'm hoping you can have some influence on them.

Could this please be attended to as soon as possible. The Council have previously made me aware that different departments deal with the litter in these areas but the work needs to be co-ordinated between them and NOT come back to me to contact each department individually, as happened the last time I contacted them about this. Could someone also speak to the shops about keeping the area outside their facility in a tidier order.

There is also an issue with the house directly opposite the shops storing litter in bin bags in the garden. This litter is spilling out and adding to the litter along Greengate Lane.

I would be grateful if someone could get back to me to confirm what action can be taken on ALL of my points.
