My father has never seen his grandchild play a game of football as he is housebound and can not get out to watch a game and a camera of this sort would give him the opportunity to see his grandchild for the first time play a game of football, this would be a massive boost to my fathers mental health not only his but the elderly grandparents of the other squad members,

The activities will be football games as well as football training, eventually we will be looking to set soccer camps up for the community for both boys and girls,
