DO NOT park on double yellow lines THESE ARE IN PLACE TO ENSURE A SAFE SPACE FOR PEOPLE, MAINLY CHILDREN TO CROSS THE ROAD – Parking Services will issue fines for anybody who does.

DO NOT park on Zig Zags – THESE ARE IN PLACE TO PROTECT DESIGNATED CROSSING AREAS - The Police and Parking Services will both issue fines for anybody who does.

ALWAYS STOP when instructed to do so by the School Cross Patrol – It is an offence not to which the Police will prosecute as appropriate.

Whilst the school year ends this is still important.
