Road Resurfacing Work

We will soon be resurfacing **Greengate Lane from the junction of Springwood Lane to outside number 58** as part of the Streets Ahead highway improvement programme.

This work is due to start **late September** and will last **approximately 1 week**, between the hours of **09:30am & 4pm, Monday – Friday only**.

Temporary road signs will be displayed up to five days before work starts, confirming the dates and any associated parking restrictions or road closures.

Our work schedule is heavily dependent on the weather and can be affected by unforeseen circumstances, so it may be necessary to change the start date at short notice.

Please note that we will need to close the road to complete these works and there will be no on-street parking during working hours. Vehicles left on-street may be towed away and you would need to pay a fee to have your vehicle released.

If you are away during the period in which the works are scheduled to take place, please avoid parking your car on the road.

Vehicle access will **not** be allowed, however, pedestrian access and access for emergency vehicles will be available at all times.
