	It was noted that at its 1 December 2022 meeting, Full Council requested (minute 2022/105 (FC)) that the Finance and Premises Committee consider and make recommendations for the

	budget and precept options for the financial year 2023/2024 for consideration at its 12 January 2023 meeting.
	Councillors were given detailed information on the proposed budget and precept based upon requirements established for the year 2023/2024. An indication was also provided with this information as to the amount of increase both per year and per week on a Band D property based upon the possible precept levels.
	Councillors then examined the proposed budget and precept options for 2023/2024 in detail.
	a) Proposed by Councillor Carol Levery and seconded by Councillor John Housley and <b>RESOLVED</b> : That it is recommended to Council that they consider an option (1) that would see no increase in the precept demand for 2023/2024.
	<ul> <li>(7 in favour)</li> <li>b) Proposed by Councillor John Brownrigg and seconded by Councillor David Ogle and <b>RESOLVED</b>: That it is recommended to Council that they consider a second option (2) that would see a 5.5% increase in the precept demand for 2023/2024 and the resulting increase in income be allocated to the ward-based grant programme.</li> </ul>

	An additional proposal by Councillor David Ogle and seconded by Councillor John Brownrigg that recommended to the Council, that the Council consider a third option which would see a £40,000 reduction in the staffing budget for 2023/2024 and the residual amount (after costs associated with the necessary restructuring and redundancy process) be allocated to the Ward Based Grant and Covid Recovery programmes was not supported.
