- No Mow May – The Clerk informed the committee that coming into May the Parish Council will be involved in No Mow May again this year, to let the grass and wildflowers grow for nature. This is a public wide event and anyone can take part.
- Neighbourhood Plan Update – The Clerk gave an update to the committee. The neighbourhood plan is progressing, and the design codes are completed. There is a display on the neighbourhood plan at the parish council and it will be placed in reception for the public to see. The plan will also be circulated to councillors and put on the council website and facebook page.

Chairman, Councillor Tim Whitaker gave an update to the committee on the public footpath level crossing in Ecclesfield West. Councillor Tim Whitaker attended a site visit with network rail and a local walking group. Some ideas were suggested to either move the footpath away from the bend so that a clearer view of oncoming trains could be seen, or a bridge built. The path is currently boarded up. It is still being investigated by network rail.
